As a local resident / trader, we highly recommend that you take the time to carefully read the following important information to make sure you are prepared for this year's festivities.

You may experience overflow noise during the event times. Regular monitoring and decibel readings will occur to ensure noise levels are kept within regulation.

It is anticipated there will be increased traffic around Pelican Park. For the safety of patrons, and to minimise congestion in the area, there will be changed traffic conditions along Hornibrook Esplanade, Clontarf. Queensland Police and traffic controllers will be onsite to direct motorists. If attending the Festival, we highly recommend walking to the Festival to ease traffic congestion in surrounding streets.

Free car parking will be available at the Redcliffe Showgrounds with free shuttle buses running to and from the event. These arrangements will be widely publicised as part of the event program.

For safety and accessibility reasons, council will install temporary on-street 'No Stopping' signs. Restrictions will apply in surrounding streets (detailed below) from approximately 6am on Saturday, 16 September to 4pm on Sunday, 17 September 2023.
